To report damaged or missing street signs, street damage, or potholes, call the Street Department at 218-5566.

To report a damaged or non-operational traffic signal, call TXU Electric at 888-313-4747 or call the Public Works Department at 218-7043 or 218-5555.

For brush pick-up service, call the Parks and Recreation Department at 218-5540 or 341-3350.

To report a water line break or low water pressure, call Public Works at 218-5555. If calling after 5 p.m., following the recorded announcement, please leave a brief message with your name and telephone number. The City crew will contact you within 30 minutes to assist you. Leaks in the water line between the meter and the building are almost always the property owners responsibility, however, the city will come and evaluate the situation if requested to do so.

### **County Courthouse Cleared for Make-Over**

All county offices have been relocated in preparation for the restoration of the historic Williamson County courthouse on the square in Georgetown. Williamson County received a grant for \$4 million from the Texas Historical Commission to bring the courthouse back to its original beauty and 1911 appearance.

Most prominent among the changes is the removal of the brick parapet installed in the mid-1960s around the top of the building and replacing the original triangular pediments and balustrades. In the interior, the second elliptical stair off the rotunda will be replaced where an elevator was installed in the 1950s. A new elevator will be installed near the south entrance of the building.

The famous 26<sup>th</sup> District Courtroom, where Williamson County District Attorney Dan Moody successfully tried the Klu Klux Klan, will have its wooden floor replaced and two-story balcony reconstructed. In addition, the original County Courtroom, currently the Commissioners Courtroom, will be restored.

Aside from cosmetic changes, the building will be updated to comply with accessibility requirements and modern office needs.

Several county offices were relocated for the renovation. In September, the County Clerk moved to the Williamson County Justice Center, 405 MLK, in Georgetown. In October, the Tax Assessor/Collector moved her Georgetown office to 904 S. Main St.

Remaining offices moved to the Williamson County Inner Loop Annex, 301 S.E. Inner Loop, at exit 259 in Georgetown. These include the County Judge, County Treasurer, County Auditor, Justice of the Peace Precinct #3, Constable Precinct #3, Human Resources, Elections and Information Technology Services. Commissioners Court will meet at the Inner Loop Annex in Justice of the Peace Precinct #3's courtroom during the restoration. Offices returning to the courthouse after the restoration include the County Judge, County Treasurer, County Auditor, Human Resources and Commissioners Court.

The restoration is expected to take 20 to 24 months, provided the project does not run into any unexpected delays. Updates will be available on the county's web site at [www.wilco.org](http://www.wilco.org) and at the Williamson County Historical Museum, 716 South Austin Avenue, in Georgetown. The museum is open Tuesday through Saturday from noon to 5 p.m.
